*Each student must have their own Safety Gear (Helmet, eye protection, boots, pants, long sleeves, gloves).

*Each student must bring their own ATV - must fit the rider and licensed.

- **Next, attend a Hands-On ATV Safety class:** On May 20th.

The Hands-On training includes: Basic ATV operation, protecting the environment, common ATV parts and controls, MN rules and laws, responsible ATV riding skills for trail riding, and practicing/demonstrating skills on an ATV course. Our local DNR Officer will also be on site to answer questions.
