




E MARGARET STREET VISITOR MAIN ENTRY **RECEIVING** PROPOSED BUILDING **ZONING B-3 ZONING R-3**

Project Objectives

- Establish prominent public entry with a strong visual connection to Margaret, while maintaining a boundary around public safety traffic and operations
- Create a welcoming and easy to navigate entry lobby with convenient access to all departments
- Design office spaces with flexibility, workspace sharing, and future expansion in mind
- Prioritize natural light and views in public waiting areas, shared workspaces, and private offices
- Plan the site and building to accommodate the addition of a full Justice Center in the future
- Provide sufficient jail capacity to eliminate the need to rent beds from other county jails, keeping the money in the County!
- Designate a separate Jail lobby & entry for added safety and comfort for visitors to the Sheriff and Police Department
